



<p><b>Fernando wins Fisico sixth First French victory for a Renault car in 22 years.</b></p> <p>Fernando Alonso took a dominant victory for the Mid-Season Renault F1 Team in this afternoon's French Grand Prix at Magny-Cours. The Spaniard led every lap of the race, and took his fifth victory of the season, and the best for a Renault Formula 1 team since 1977. The last champion to lead in the drivers' championship by two points, and now has 65 points, 24 ahead of second, and third Red Bull.</p> <p>Yesterday, Giancarlo Fisichella survived a troubled afternoon, suffering problems at runs of low grip percentage and damage to his car which cost him grip from mid-race onwards. He nevertheless delivered a meticulous performance, and was promoted to fourth, which earned the team the advantage in the Constructors' Championship. The team now leads Williams by 18 points, with a total of 89 points.</p> <p><b>Fernando Alonso, Winner</b> "I am very proud to win here today for the team. But for the moment, I am going to enjoy what we achieved today."</p> <p><b>Giancarlo Fisichella, 4th position</b></p> <p>"Actually I think this was a good race for me – in spite of the starting position. I had a problem with the fuel cap at my first stop, which cost me a lot of positions; then the impacts for the understeer at the start broke in the middle of the race, which cost me a lot of grip and damaged the front tire. But after that, I managed to get back up, so really, with all of those changes, I think it's a good result. Of course, I am frustrated because today could have been a perfect day for me, but the main thing is that we gained more points than the other teams, and improved our situation in the championship."</p> <p><b>Flavio Briatore, Managing Director</b></p> <p>"The whole year, I am afraid, performed as under the weather. We did the same – after the events in Indianapolis in last year, I packed until the last stop, and then considered the paper only making small adjustments to the car. I am really pleased it was again for this still does not change anything for the championship. I have quite a good paper on Renault, but there is still a lot of work to do. Anything can happen, and we know our rivals will be very quick in Silverstone next week. But for the moment, I am going to enjoy what we achieved today."</p> <p><b>Pat Symonds, Executive Director of Engineering</b></p> <p>"Congratulations go to Fernando on a superb fifth win of the season. He dominated the weekend, and fully deserved the victory. It was an excellent race, and we focus on silverstone, where we should have less a double problem front, through three separate track days for Giancarlo. The fact that he finished sixth in spite of these is an indication of how good a race he drove this afternoon."</p> <p><b>Giancarlo Fisichella, driver</b> "Strongly, driver strongly from position six to clear the track of the middle portion of the race. My team is still behind when I come out after my last stop, but it's a bit surprising to lose a few lapses of that, but this is still a great result for me."</p> <p><b>Giancarlo Fisichella, 4th position</b></p> <p>"Once again, it is a bit of a disappointing race result for me, because I think I did a good job, but today it is not enough for the podium in my second race. But once we leave F1 it is very a very strong team for me, the strategy the team worked out was excellent and I was in the fight at the front of the race with a good race pace.
